Upon motion of Willard Lamb, seconded by Howard Kingsley,
the following resolution was unanimously adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED that the Town Board shall hold a public hearing
at the Otisco Grange Hall, Otisco, New York, on the 16th day of
October, 1967 at 7 o'clock in the evening of said day, upon the
enactment of an ordinance in manner following:

BINGO ORDINANCE

Be it ordained as follows:

1. That it shall be lawful for authorized organizations,
upon obtaining a license therefor, to conduct games of bingo
within the limits of the Town of Otisco under the provisions of
this ordinance, the provisions of the Bingo Control and Licensing
Laws of the State of New York and any amendments thereto.
2. That the provisions of the Bingo Control and Licensing
Laws of the State of New York control the licensing of organiza-
tions and the conduct of bingo games in the Town of Otisco and
this ordinance incorporates the provisions of those statutes by
reference as if set forth in full herein. Any inconsistency be-
tween this ordinance and the said statutes shall be resolved in
favor of those statutes.

3. This ordinance shall take effect January 1st, 1968 in the event that at a referendum held for that purpose, a majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Otisco shall approve the same by voting for the proposition.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk cause a notice of such public hearing containing a copy of the above mentioned ordinance, to be prepared and published in the Marcellus Observer and the Tully Independent on or before the 6th day of October, 1967.
