A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN NY GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 3-C FOR BUDGET YEAR 2018

Section 1. TITLE.

This Local Law shall be known as "A Local Law Authorizing a Property Tax Levy in Excess of the Limit Established in NY General Municipal Law, Article 2, Section 3-C for Budget Year 2018."

Section 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of this Local Law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Otisco, County of Onondaga, pursuant to General Municipal Law § 3-C, and to allow the Town of Otisco, County of Onondaga, to adopt a Town budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2018, and ending December 31, 2018, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-C.

Section 3. AUTHORITY.

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-C, which expressly authorizes the Town Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of at least sixty percent (60%) of the Town Board.

Section 4. TAX LEVY LIMIT OVERRIDE.

The Town Board of the Town of Otisco, County of Onondaga, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2018, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law §3-C.

Section 5. CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Town Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York. During the duration of times that this Local Law is in effect, to the extent permitted by law, it shall take precedence over and shall be considered controlling over contrary laws, ordinances and provisions including, but not limited to, the statutes set forth in the New York Town Law. Specifically, this Law is intended to supersede Town Law Sections 130, 261, 262, 263, 264, 265, 267, 267-1, 267-b, 268, 269, 274-1, 274-b, 276, 277, 278 and 279.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, subdivision, provision, or part of this Local Law, shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be void, invalid, or unenforceable, such adjudication or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operations and only apply to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, subdivision, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such adjudication or judgment shall have been rendered or so adjudged, and the remainder of this Local Law shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law No. 1 of 2017 shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
