Captain Vincent Ferrara , from the Onondaga County Sheriffs Department addressed the Town Board and residents from the Park Avenue area regarding the loud music being constantly played at all hours of the day by one resident. Captain Ferrara explained with Noise Ordinances each case can be different ie: some levels of the noise bother some people and not others. Some towns use decibels and some don't. He explained it's a hard case to solve. Some people don't care if they are fined by a Court Summons for a violation of a Noise Ordinance and will continue and some people will stop. Captain Ferrara assured the residents they have the right to call the Sheriffs Department when they feel the necessity.

Linda Kelly and Teri Lore addressed the Town Board to discuss the possibility of a Pickle Ball court at the Town Park.. The board was in favor of the Pickle Ball at the park and the board offered to provide the tape for marking a portion of the tennis courts for Pickle Ball.

Mike Wheeler asked if we had anymore information on the Henderson property. He stated the lawn is not currently being mowed. Supervisor Glenn Hall said he would follow up on it.
